

CIUDAD QUESADA



Ciudad Quesada is part of Rojales and includes the urbanizations of Pueblo Lucero, Doña Pepa, Pueblo Bravo and Lo Pepín. It is very popular with expats from all over Europe and is instantly recognisable by the grand entrance known as the Quesada Arches. It has a large square, a town hall, La Marquesa Golf Course, free municipal tennis courts, Parque Acuatico (water park) and the Parque Recorral which has picnic benches and many unmarked walking and cycling routes, the Blue Flag beaches of Guardamar Del Segura and Torrevieja are less than a 10 minute drive away.

The buzzing high street is full of bars, cafes and restaurants, which offer international food including Spanish, Thai, Indian, Italian, French, Greek and Chinese. There are also a few steak houses and fast food establishments. It is a real hub and is especially busy in the mornings with people wandering around the shops and enjoying coffees.
