

SAN PEDRO DEL PINATAR



San Pedro Del Pinatar is the most northerly of all the towns and villages that sit on the shores of the Mar Menor and is well worth a visit. There are lots of places to discover, such as the marina and the beaches which have a very rural feel. There is the information centre for the Salinas Regional Park with its sand dunes and salt flats, making it a very important wetland area for birds. It is easy to spend a whole day there at the park, marina, beach or in the town centre which is especially busy on a Monday as it is market day.

It is a great place to explore by bike as you can park on the road beside the information centre and complete a circular route including the mud baths at Lo Pagan and the Salinas Regional Park.
