

## TORRE DE LA HORADADA



**Torre de la Horadada** is part of Pilar de la Horadada and is easily recognisable by its watchtower, which was built as part of the coastal communication system to warn of impending attacks by pirates. It has two large village squares (plazas) both with shops, bars and an abundance of eateries, a church, a couple of lovely sandy beaches, a quaint marina and a long promenade which joins the beaches of El Mojón to the south and Mil Palmeras to the north.
